


The beach is alive!

Coloring book






Once upon time,,,


As you can see, there were many inhabitants of the beaches enjoying themselves.






On this beach, all the animals and plants were friends.

This meadow was very important for the beach.




The animals found refuge
in it and lots of food.






Incredible! Isn't it?









Posidonia forests suffered constant impacts... and, each time, the sea was much dirtier.





The huge crowds at the seaside in the summer and their demands as well as economic interests, mean that some of the activities taking place on beaches, on the seabed or in the dunes can directly affect the future of their conservation.

Listed below are some of the initiatives we can put into practice on the beaches that are very important:

- Avoid anchoring over the posidonia meadows.
- Avoid throwing waste from boats.
- Respect all the animals and plants living at the seaside.
- Avoid treading on the vegetation in the dunes.
- Use car parks in a civil way.
- Do not throw cigarette ends, nor rubbish onto the beach nor into the sea.
- Do not camp nor light fires.
- Do not make demands for services on the beaches (showers, snack bars...).
- Do not take pets to the beach.
- Try not to be noisy.
- Do not walk over the dunes.
- Never leave a bag of rubbish on the beach.
- As users of the beach, do not demand the removal of the posidonia leaves. Many people still do not understand the value of these plants (for every kilo of posidonia removed, we lose 2 kilos of sand).
- Before leaving the beach, shake the sand out of towels and shoes. Leave the sand on the beach. Each one of us is capable of taking 30 grams of sand, nearly the same amount that one square meter of posidonia produces annually.
